Requirements for abstracts:

- 1. The maximum number of co-authors of one abstract is two.
- 2. Working languages of the conference: Ukrainian, English.
- 3. Abstracts of **2-4 full pages** of A4 format including illustrations, tables and references prepared in Microsoft Word (with the extension *.doc), the orientation is portrait; pages are not numbered.
- 4. The font is Times New Roman, size 14, normal, aligned in width, paragraph indentation 1.25 cm, line spacing 1.5 pt.
- 5. Margins: top, bottom, right and left -20 mm.
- 6. File name the name of the first author (for example: **Hlavatska_abstracts.doc**).

Procedure for submitting an abstract:

- 1. The title of the section (the upper left corner).
- 2. In 1 line: surname, initials of the author, surname, initials of the co-author (in bold), position, academic degree, academic title.
- 3. In 1 line in bold the centered title of the abstract in **CAPITAL LETTERS**.
- 4. In 1 line the main text.
- 5. At the end of the text in 1 line references drawn up according to DSTU 8302:2015 under the heading **References** (in bold).
 - 6. References to the sources used in the text are given in square brackets [1, p. 25].

Abstracts must comply with the spelling and formatting standards.

Abstracts that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted for consideration.

The authors are responsible for the content and accuracy of the information provided in the abstracts.

Authors are responsible for the content, accuracy of the submitted materials and no plagiarism.

The submitted materials are not subject to peer review and are published in the author's version.

By agreeing to participate in the conference, the author(s) agrees to the publication of their reports on the Internet.

LEGAL TERMS: DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS

Legal term is an element of legal technique, verbal designations of state-legal concepts, with the help of which the content of the normative-legal prescriptions of the state is expressed and fixed. Legal terms can be classified in the following way: a) general terms (characterized by the fact that they are used in the usual sense and understood by everyone): *judge*, *defendant*, *lawyer*; b) special legal terms that have a special legal meaning: *authorized share capital*, *special resolution*, *a fixed charge* [2, p. 33].
